Getting to the Exhibition

This exhibition is located at Dalam Southeast Asia, Level 3 of the Supreme Court Wing.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed towards the Supreme Court Foyer and to Lift Lobby E. Take the accessible lift to Level 3. The exhibition entrance is located near Lift Lobby E.

You may also enter the exhibition via the Lower Link Bridge located at Level 3, which links the Supreme Court Wing and City Hall Wing. The bridge slopes down from the City Hall Wing and the doors to the bridge are automated.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the exhibition is Lift Lobby E.

Entrance and Exit: There is step-free access to the gallery space. Please note that you will need to open a heavy, manual glass door to access the gallery, but there are staff nearby to provide assistance if necessary.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilets are located near Lift Lobby B, in the City Hall Wing. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual door to get to the accessible toilets.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are located near Lift Lobbies A and B.

General Exhibition Accessibility

Wheelchair Accessibility: The exhibition space is wheelchair-accessible.

Seating: Seating is not available in the exhibition. The nearest seating area is located outside the exhibition space, at the Supreme Court Foyer.

Lighting: The exhibition space is well-lit.

Protruding Objects: There are two installations in the *City* section of the exhibition space that protrude from the wall. Please be mindful of your step and belongings.

Exhibition Content: Exhibition texts are available in Malay, Tamil and Chinese as digital room sheets, which can be accessed via the QR code at the entrance of the exhibition.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the exhibition for any additional support you may require.
