Getting to the Exhibition

The exhibition is located at the Level 4 Gallery, on Level 4 of the City Hall Wing.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level 4. From Lift Lobby A, proceed down the hallway past the Wu Guanzhong Gallery and City Hall Foyer. The exhibition entrance is located at the end of the hallway, opposite Lift Lobby B.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the exhibition is Lift Lobby B.

Entrance and Exit: There is step-free access to the Level 4 Gallery. However, please note that there are manual glass doors at both the entrance and exit of the exhibition. If necessary, there are staff nearby who can provide assistance.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilets are located near Lift Lobbies A and B. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual door to get to the accessible toilets.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are also located near Lift Lobbies A and B.

General Exhibition Accessibility

Wheelchair Accessibility: The exhibition is wheelchair-accessible.

Seating: There is limited seating available throughout the exhibition. Please note that the seats do not have armrests or backrests.

Lighting: The exhibition space is well-lit.

Exhibition Content: Exhibition texts are available in both English and Chinese. They are also available in Malay and Tamil as digital files, which can be accessed via the QR code at the entrance of the exhibition.

Audio-visual Material: Captions in English and Mandarin are available for the videos shown in the exhibition.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the exhibition for any additional support you may require.
