# **Exhibition Access Advisory**

National Gallery Singapore is committed to creating an inclusive experience for our diverse audiences. We have also worked with <u>LevelField Consultants</u> to ensure accessibility in our gallery space. For information on getting to National Gallery Singapore and the available access provisions, please refer to the Gallery Access Guide.

### **Getting to the Exhibition**

The exhibition is located at DBS Singapore Gallery 1, on Level 2 of the City Hall Wing.

**From Coleman Street Entrance**: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level 2. From Lift Lobby A, turn right and proceed down the hallway. The exhibition entrance is located next to the steps at the Singapore Courtyard.

**Nearest Lift Lobby**: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the exhibition is Lift Lobby B.

**Entrance and Exit:** Please note that step-free access to Gallery 1 is located at the exit of that Gallery, near Lift Lobby B.

**Accessible Toilets:** The nearest accessible toilets are located near Lift Lobbies A and B. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual door to get to the accessible toilets at both lift lobbies.

**Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms:** Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are also located near Lift Lobbies A and B.

## **General Exhibition Accessibility**

**Wheelchair Accessibility**: The exhibition is wheelchair-accessible. Certain areas of the exhibition galleries have floors that are sloped.

**Seating**: Seating is available but limited throughout the exhibition. Please note that the benches near the exit of the gallery do not have armrests or backrests.

**Lighting**: The exhibition space is generally well-lit, with the exception of the "Moving Images" section. This section is dimly lit to accommodate film screenings which form part of the exhibition display. Please mind your step.

#### **Exhibition Content:**

- Exhibition texts are available in Malay, Tamil and Chinese on our website, which can be accessed via the QR code at the entrance of the exhibition.
- English subtitles are available for all video content.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the exhibition for any additional support you may require.
