Getting to the Artwork

This artwork is located at the City Hall Wing, Level 5, Ng Teng Fong Roof Garden Gallery.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level 5. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual glass door to access the roof garden. The artwork is in the middle of the space on an elevated platform.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the Ng Teng Fong Roof Garden Gallery is Lift Lobby B.

Entrance and Exit: Please note that the artwork is displayed on an elevated platform. You will need to either climb a flight of steps or use the ramp to access the gallery.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilets are located near Lift Lobbies A and B in the City Hall Wing. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual glass door to get to the accessible toilets.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are located near Lift Lobbies A and B.

General Space Accessibility

Wheelchair Accessibility: The space is wheelchair-accessible.

Seating: There are limited seats in the space.

Bright lights: Please note that the artwork features reflective discs that shimmer under the light of the sun. If you are sensitive to bright and flickering lights, please be mindful of the glaring lights.

Shelter: Please note that the artwork is located in an open-air area and is not sheltered.

Exhibition Content: The artwork label is only available in English.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the Gallery for any additional support you may require.
